Donations of *all* sizes make an impact in the lives of San Leandro students.

Diana is a Senior at San Leandro High School. She hopes to be the first member in her family to attend college. She is doing all of the right things to make that happen. She is keeping her grades up and taking advantage of the resources offered at her school, including taking the *free* SAT offered by the school when she was Junior. Diana didn't do as well as she had hoped on the test, she knew she could do better and wanted to take the exam again as a Senior. But Diana's father had just lost his job and she knew her family couldn't afford the \$78 fee for the test. Her counselor reached out to see if SLED could help. Each year SLED designates its funds to support a variety of programs but we always set some aside for special requests that may arise—requests like Diana's. Is it possible that the second score will make the difference in her college application? Very possible. It may sound overly dramatic, but that \$78 may change the trajectory of Diana's educational path.

SLED is fortunate to have committed supporters who donate each and every month through sustained giving. Some donors give \$5 a month and have been for years; last year we received over \$4,000 from small monthly contributions. Others, are able to give more. Last July **Mike Wiesner**, the owner of **Paradiso Restaurant** and long-time **SLED100** member, was inspired to make a sustained commitment of \$1,000 each

month. Whether it is \$5 or \$1,000, monthly contributions help form a solid foundation for our work so that when we get a request like Diana's, we can say "YES!"

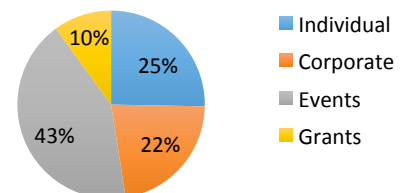

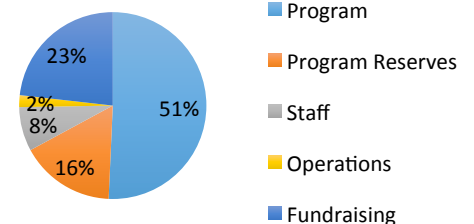

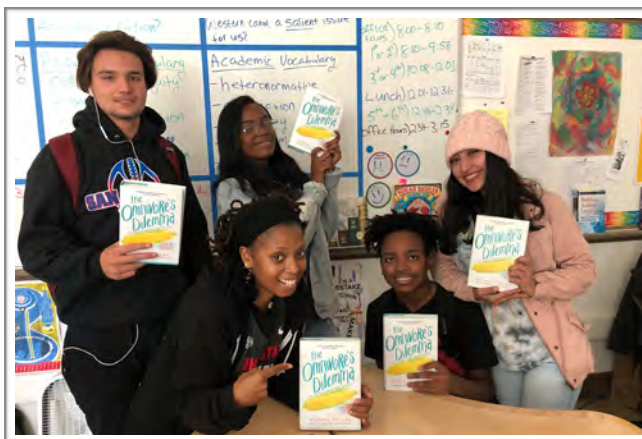
SLED Teacher Mini-Grants

Getting resources directly into the classroom.

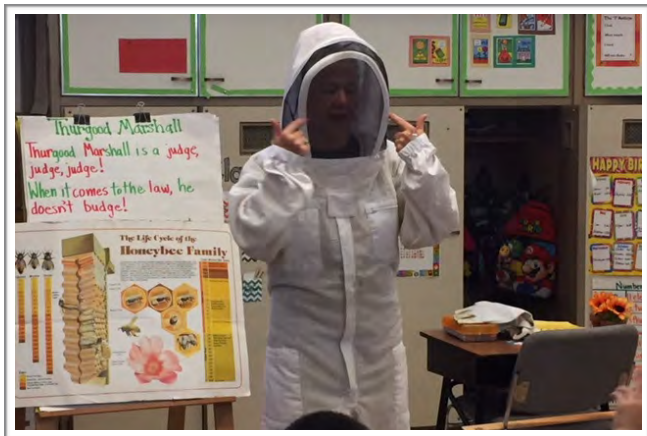
The average teacher in America spends **\$600 a year out of their own pocket** for classroom supplies. We don't think this is right. Last year SLED piloted a **Teacher Mini-Grant** program designed to get the materials elementary school teachers need for **Project Based Learning** directly into the classroom. **We funded thirty-six projects totaling \$16,730.** This year we refined the process, making it easier for teachers to apply and are expanding the program. In addition to all eight elementary schools, we have designated funds for both middle schools, the high school, Lincoln Alternative Education Center and the Adult School. All told, **we plan to award \$38,663** in materials and field trip support directly to teachers!
